Another amazing chapter out of beloved San Francisco Graffiti Godfather Cuba's (AKA – Clarence Robbs) never-ending super sketchbook of graffiti masterpieces. Functioning as both a daily/weekly diary of current events and a style-book of letterforms illuminating his encyclopedic knowledge of graffiti. Cuba's hand-painted exuberant illuminated manuscripts are unique in both the library world and the close-knit underground of the graffiti scene where style-books rarely see the light of day.

Unbound by any conventions of either biography or book-making, Cuba's unique artists' books have more in common with medieval Arabic manuscripts than with contemporary, printed, limited edition, artists' books.
